What are the differences in itinerary for each cruise?

Itineraries are detailed on the cruise description overview on our website. A brief overview of each itinerary is also detailed on page 1 of this document.

Will guests have any help with luggage?

The cruise manager or a crew member will be at hand to help with luggage when boarding the cruise and when disembarking to guests return transfer vehicle.

What meals are included?

Whilst on the cruise, only breakfast and lunch are included.

What style of dining is it during the cruise?

During the cruise, it is à la carte dining for breakfast and lunch, from a set menu. Lunch on the 4* boats consist of 3 courses, and lunch on the 4* plus boats consist of 4 courses.

There is a free seating arrangement and tables are often shared with other passengers.

Are special diets catered for? (e.g. Gluten free, vegetarian)

Guests dietary requirements should be made known to the cruise manager on the first day upon arrival. Similar to most hotels, and stated in our Essential Holiday Information, special diets of any kind can seldom be catered for adequately within the constraints of a set menu and cannot be guaranteed. However, the cruise kitchen staff will do all they can to ensure a suitable option is provided.

Where will guests have their evening meal whilst on the cruise?

The boat will dock at a different harbour every afternoon. This allows guests to explore the local area and dine at a restaurant of their choice on an evening (payable locally).

Is it possible to purchase evening meals on the boat?

Evening meals are available to purchase on the boat, subject to occupancy. There needs to be a minimum of 10 persons. However, at every port there are plenty of dining options you can choose from.

Can I bring my own food and drink on board?

The cruise boats do not allow any food or drinks to be brought on board that have been purchased on-shore.

Does the boat sail through the night?

No, the boat docks at a different harbour every afternoon and will set sail again the following morning.

When is the bar open? What drinks are served?

The bar on board is open between 12pm and 12am. Both local and international drinks are available. It is recommended not to drink tap water, however bottled water (0.5l per person per day) is provided to all guests on board.

Can I use a card on board?

No. Any purchases, including drinks, must be paid for in cash (Euro) at the end of the cruise.

Are any excursions, guided tours or tickets etc. included in the package?

Any included tours/ tickets will be referenced on the special offers section of the cruise on our website. There is also a dedicated Cruise Manager on board for the duration of the cruise to offer expert advice and recommendations of the local area.

Are there ramps and lifts on board?

There are ramps, but not lifts between floors on the boat.

Is there an entertainment programme on the boat?

No. Guests can spend their free time on the boat on the sundeck and swimming in the ocean during swim-stops. At each port stop there may be local entertainment to enjoy on an evening in the bars and restaurants.

Are there snorkel masks available on board?

This is not guaranteed but snorkel masks are available to buy at each port.

How many sun loungers are on board?

There will be approximately 12 sun loungers, along with tables and chairs on the spacious sun deck.

Are beach towels available?

Beach towels are available to hire for €5 and can only be changed once or twice a week.

What is the crew to passenger ratio on each cruise?

About 1:6. Each boat sails with around 40 guests.

Will guests be required to pay Tourist Tax and Port Tax whilst on the cruise?

No, these taxes are included in the price for the cruise.

When will I need to vacate the boat on the final day?

Guests are required to vacate the boat after breakfast on their final day. If there is a long period between vacating the boat and their return flight time, the cruise staff are able to securely store their luggage before the transfer pick up arrives, allowing guests to explore the departure point (Split or Dubrovnik).

When will guests receive departure transfer details/ arrangements?

Departure transfer times and arrangements will be displayed on the boat's information board 48 hrs prior to traveling.

- Search for a **Saturday** departure for cruises departing from **Split**.
- Search for a **Saturday** or **Sunday** departure for cruises departing from **Dubrovnik**.
